Heading for the Epicenter

On the eve of the Spring Festival, a traditional Chinese holiday for family reunion, officers and soldiers of the Chinese military volunteered to head for Wuhan, the epicenter of the outbreak. Fearing neither difficulty nor death, the service members fought side by side with the affected population to build a strong great wall against the disease.
